The **Monthly Mission & Ministry** offering for April is “Faith Comes by Hearing”. In the past, our contributions went to purchasing Military BibleSticks. Peace donated 299 Bible sticks to date. Beginning in April, God’s Word will be distributed by QR Code and can be downloaded on your phone for free. There are business cards with the QR code in the Narthex that you can take and hand out to family, friends, neighbors, etc. More than half the world learns by listening. Audio is the only way many can access God’s Word. By the year 2033 they have an ambitious goal to get every language of the Bible in the world recorded in Audio and make those recordings available for free! At Faith Comes By Hearing they have 2033 Scripture Recordings available for free, but there are over 7000 Languages spoken in the world! That is 1.5 billion people that still need to hear the Scriptures to understand and come to know Jesus. All donations will be matched throughout the month of May and June by a donor.
